



Hydrocarbon Stain Removal Chart

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Dry-Side Stains

HEAVY, OILY & GREASY STAINS



Asphalt. Crayon.
Enamel. Grease.
Oil. Paint.
Tar. Varnish.

If stain is gone

When rinsing spotting agents in drycleaning with steam or water, it is important to control moisture or "level" to help prevent spotting rings and fabric damage. To level:

1. After fabric has been rinsed and air-dried, apply leveling agent liberally to the treated areas.
2. Lightly tamp the wet area, including fabric area just outside of the ring.
3. Do not flush, rinse, or dry.
4. Continue with drycleaning process.
