## Cationic Detergent for Load Process (Injection) Use in Perchloroethylene



**TOP CAT** is formulated to be the top performance cationic injection detergent for perc. As a properly formulated cationic substantive detergent, **TOP CAT** provides lubrication to fibers for a soft hand, prevents static and lubricates zippers - but will not build up or form gummy residue on fabric or in equipment.

**TOP CAT's** advanced formula provides:

- Effective stain removal

- A soft hand and drape
- Effective removal of "sweet spots" and control of static without adding additional water
- Superior lint control
- Excellent control over redeposition

# TOP CAT Use Instructions

**For professional drycleaning use only. Before using any chemical product, review the Safety Data Sheet (SDS) for safe handling and proper disposal.**

## Load Process (Injection) Use

- Although not required, for best results, a 3-minute batch prewash is recommended to remove loose soil, grease, bleeding dyes, and stain removal additives. For heavy soil or potential dye bleed items, a 3-minute batch prewash is strongly recommended.
- After 1 minute of fill, and once garments are wet with solvent, inject **TOP CAT** either into the wheel, fill line, or button trap. NOTE: if detergent is injected into the button trap or fills through a filter, delay detergent injection until fill is finished and "milling"\* starts—normally about 30 seconds.
- For soil and stain removal, inject **TOP CAT** at a rate of 2 oz. per 10 lbs. (130 mL per 10 kg) of garments.
- Run 5 minutes with circulating solvent, bypassing filter (milling\*) to release soil.
- Fill wheel to high level from work tank and inject sizing if desired, circulate through filter system for 5 to 10 minutes (depended on amount of soil and flow rate in the machine) to remove released soil.

**NOTE:** Fragile garments should be run 3 minutes on batch (or milling\*) then 3 minutes on filter to reduce mechanical action. Do not prewash.

**NOTE:** Garments pre-treated with water-based spotters should be allowed to partially dry before cleaning.

\* "Milling" means circulation from wheel through button trap and back to wheel (no filter).
