WETCLEANING SIZING



AquaSize is formulated to help restore and maintain the “like new” finish and hand of wetcleaned and laundered items. **AquaSize** has been specifically formulated for professional wetcleaning of garments but also is effective for “wash and fold” and other laundry applications where sizing is desired.

AquaSize:

- Is designed for use as a finish for wetcleaned wools, silks, cottons, rayons, blends and other fine fabrics.
- Helps restore and maintain the “Like New Finish” to wetcleaned and laundered items that customers expect.
- Reduces finishing time.
- Gives garments a more wrinkle-free finish.
- Helps finished garments hold their shape and keep their natural drape.
- Is versatile: For use in all wetcleaning systems and washing machines
- Is fantastic for tuxedo shirts, linen items and more
- Can be used in conjunction with **Laidlaw SoftenAll®** in the final rinse to produce a superior finished garment with both a soft hand, and excellent fabric memory
- Is biodegradable

Laidlaw AquaSize Use Instructions

For professional wetcleaning and laundry use only. Before using any chemical product, review the Safety Data Sheet (SDS) for safe handling and proper disposal.

Laundry or Wetcleaning Use

Follow garment care label and garment fiber content and construction to select appropriate washing and drying settings and finishing methods.

- After cleaning with a wetcleaning detergent like **Laidlaw POWERBRITE®** or **Laidlaw Soft 'N Brite®** add **AquaSize** in at the beginning of the final rinse.
- Rinse step time should be 4 minutes at 70°F – 80°F (21°C – 27°C). A low water level is preferred.
- The amount of **AquaSize** can be adjusted depending on the type of garments and the feel you desire:

For a Light Finish:

- Use 1 – 2 oz. (30 – 60 mL) of **AquaSize** per 10 lbs. (4.5 kg) of fabric.

For a Medium Finish:

- Use 2 – 3 oz. (60 – 90 mL) of **AquaSize** per 10 lbs. (4.5 kg) of fabric.
- Extract and dry.

How to Order AquaSize

Order from your authorized Adco –Laidlaw local distributor in 1-gallon containers, boxes of four 1-gallon containers, 5-gallon pails, and 15-gallon drums.
